Thanks for your interest in becoming a Certified Practitioner of Sapphire® Imagery. The process is exciting, deep, and takes time.

Anyone may apply for consideration as a student at the School of Images. Before you apply, we recommend that you take some courses first, especially **Introduction to DreamOpening** and **Morphology | Four Grids**. These and other classes and workshops will give you a grounding in what we do and how we approach this work. The process of becoming a formal student may take time. It starts with these four simple steps:

Create a WORD or PDF document with answers to the ten questions below, following the order of the questions.

Provide a clear headshot photo (like a color passport photo). We can only accept jpeg or png formats for photos.

Email these materials to the address below. Note we cannot accept Google sheets, shared documents or other formats.

The email subject line should read:
"Sapphire® application for [Your Name]"

Once we have received these materials, we will contact you about setting up an interview where we can get to know each other better. That will happen within two weeks of receiving this complete packet.

Please provide answers to the ten questions at right. This will help us to know if we have others in your area who can support your study and practice, if you have a professional or informal background that relates to our work, and more.

Reminder: We can only accept WORD or PDF formats for your answers to the questions, and jpeg or png formats for your photo.
